



Boat cleaning certification

In order to prevent the introduction and spreading of invasive aquatic species such as the Quagga Mussel (*Dreissena rostriformis*) or the Magnificent Bryozoan (*Pectinatella magnifica*) in the lakes Verbano and Ceresio, a thorough cleaning process of boats is essential, either straight after lifting them out of water or before the vessels enter new waters. Shipyards authorised to carry out both boat cleaning and bilge water pumping fill up and sign the following form. The form then needs to be submitted to boat registration offices and tourism infodesks, which grant temporary navigation permission.
